

Instructions for Installing Ringtones

iPhone:

1. Install ringtones into iTunes by double-clicking on the .m4r files, or dragging them onto the iTunes icon. You can verify they have been added and preview them by navigating to View > Media Kind > Tones and looking for the LIGO tones.
2. Select your iPhone/iPad from the list of devices in iTunes.
3. In the sidebar, click on the Tones section.
4. Make sure **Sync Tones** is checked, and either choose to sync all tones, or check the LIGO tones in the **Selected Tones** list.
5. Sync your device.
6. Open the Settings app on your device and choose Sounds. Your LIGO tones should be available to assign to any desired system sound including ringtone or text tone.

Android:

1. Connect your phone to your computer with a USB cable.
2. Open the Android phone icon that appears in the My Computer folder. For Macs, you'll need the [Android File Transfer](https://www.android.com/filetransfer/) tool (<https://www.android.com/filetransfer/>).
3. If you do not see the icon on your computer, unlock your phone.
4. Add the ringtone file to the Ringtones folder, which can either be in the main directory or /media/audio/ringtones.
5. Open Settings on your phone and select **Sound**, then select **Phone Ringtone**.
6. Choose the ringtone you uploaded.
